



COVID-19 VACCINATIONS STARTED AT POLK STREET

UHS has received its first shipment of vaccines for COVID-19 immunization (Moderna) in limited doses. At this time, due to the limited amount of the vaccines, we are scheduling vaccinations for patients older than 65 years old with high-risk medical conditions, such as cancer and immunocompromised (sub-prioritized group 1b). Vaccinations are by appointment only at Polk Street. UHS will be reaching out to members when their risk class is eligible for vaccinations and when vaccines are available. Members must be available on the day given for their second dose (28 days after their first dose).



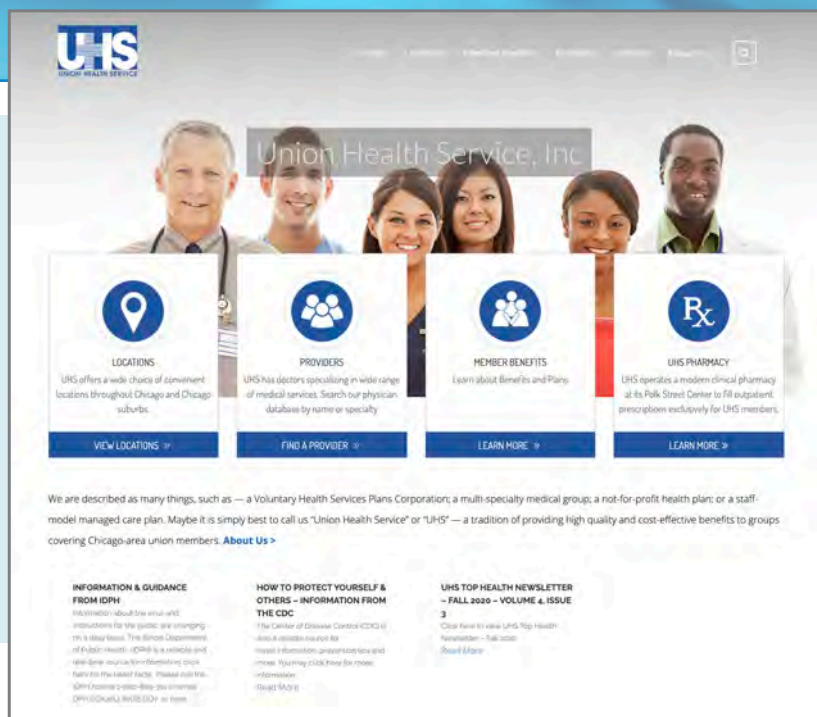

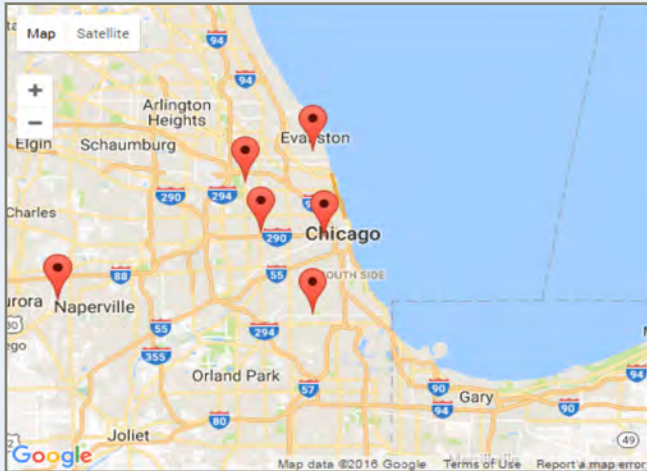

FOLLOW THESE FIVE EASY STEPS TO HELP PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19



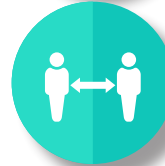
Sneeze or cough? Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or use your elbow.
